CODE OF CONDUCT

1. INTRODUCTION

- A. All members of the Mid-State Microd Club, drivers, handlers, officials and sponsors are expected to abide by these rules.
- B. These rules are to be read and followed by all active Club members.
- C. All rules have been written with the intent of being fully enforced by the Board of Directors.
- D. Rule supplements, additions, or corrections shall be announced by the Club President as soon as possible after they have been passed by the Board of Directors. Upon such announcement, rule changes become legal and enforceable.

2. CODE OF CONDUCT

- A. All club members and their families are expected to act in a manner that is a credit to the sport, both on and off the track facility; when attending Club sanctioned events. Undue disturbances, unsportsmanlike conduct, abusive or offensive language, or willful damage to other's property will not be tolerated at any time.
- B. Those failing to act in a manner that is a credit to the sport are hampering all members and are jeopardizing the existence and future of microding.
- C. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs in the pits or on the track during the race program.
- D. Persons under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs will not be allowed in the pits or on the track during the race program.
- E. Only members with NYSMA insurance are allowed in the pit area during a race program

3. ENFORCEMENT

- A. Violations of Conduct Complaint forms will be available and accessible to all members during every race. (Concession Stand & Scoring Booth).

- B. Any violation noted by a member (child or adult) will be written on one of these forms and given immediately (within reason) to one of the Club Directors. The Board of Directors will then meet to determine the appropriate action.
- C. The President and the Club Secretary will be in attendance to record any decisions made by the Board of Directors, but will not have a vote in the proceedings. Rulings made by the Board of Directors will be limited to the day's race schedule. All rulings by the Board of Directors will be determined by majority vote.
- D. The Board of Directors shall have the right to issue anyone of the following:
 - 1. Issue no sanction
 - 2. Issue one verbal warning
 - 3. Issue one written warning
 - 4. Issue an immediate disqualification (any offense which results in disqualification may carry a fine of all points earned on that racing night being revoked, be that offense against a driver or pit personnel).
 - a. Anything, which delays or prevents the normal course of a race, or conduct, which can be construed by spectators as unsportsmanlike or improper, will result in an immediate disqualification.
 - b. Willful damage of another's property will result in an immediate disqualification.
 - c. Fighting will result in an immediate disqualification and/or suspension for the racing season.
 - 5. Immediate suspension for the race season without a return of registration or membership fees.
- E. The Board of Directors has determined that:
 - 1. Two conduct violations within a racing season will result in a 1-week suspension from the Club and missing the next point race.
 - 2. Three conduct violations within a racing season will result in loss of family membership within the Club.
 - a. Members may be reinstated to the Club following a favorable review by the Board of Directors.
