

AGE & CLASS INFORMATION – 2003

Classic Division

Novice – Must be five (5) years old by May 1st of the racing season year, or can compete immediately following fifth (5th) birthday.

Maximum age is ten (10) years old. The eleventh (11th) birthday must be after July 15th of the racing season year.

MR1 Classic - Must be eleven (11) years old by May 1st of the racing season year. Drivers nine (9) years old on or before May 1st of the racing season year and having two (2) years of experience may race in this class. Drivers ten (10) years old on or before May 1st of the racing season year and having one (1) year of experience may race in this class.

Maximum age is fourteen (14) years old. The fifteenth (15) birthday must be after July 15th of the racing season year.

Micro Division

Jr. Novice – Must be five (5) years old on or before May 1st of the racing season year. Or can compete after fifth (5th) birthday.

Maximum age is seven (7) years old. The eighth birthday must be on or before May 1st of the racing season year.

Any driver who reaches their eighth (8th) birthday before May 1st of the racing season year must move up to the Novice Class.

Novice – Must be eight (8) years old on or before May 1st of the racing season year.

Maximum age is eleven (11) years old. The twelfth (12th) birthday must be on or before July 15th of the racing season year.

The driver may remain in this class for a maximum of three (3) years and two (2) racing seasons.

Limited – Must be eleven (11) years old on or before July 15th of the racing season year.

Drivers who are nine (9) years old and have two (2) years experience can race in this class.

The ninth (9th) birthday must be on or before July 15th of the racing season year.

Drivers who are ten (10) years old and have raced in the Novice class previously, can race in this class.

Maximum age is thirteen (13) years old. The fourteenth (14th) birthday must be after July 15th of the racing season year.

A new or inexperienced driver fourteen (14) years old will have the option of racing for one (1) year only in this class, with the permission of the members individual club Officers and Directors. The fourteenth (14th) birthday must be after July 15th of the racing season year.

Stock – Must be twelve (12) years old. The twelfth (12th) birthday must be on or before July 15th of the racing season year.

Drivers who are ten (10) years old and have two (2) years experience can race in this class.

The tenth (10th) birthday must be on or before July 15th of the racing season year.

Driver who are eleven (11) years old and have raced Novice or Limited class previously, can race in this class.

Maximum age is fifteen (15) years old. The sixteenth (16th) birthday must be after July 15th of the racing season year.

A new or inexperienced driver sixteen (16) years old will have the option of racing for one (1) year only in this class with the permission of the individual club Officers and Directors. The sixteenth (16th) birthday must be after July 15th of the racing season year.

Open Wheel Division

Stock - Must be at least twelve (12) years old. The twelfth (12th) birthday must be on or before July 15th of the racing season. Drivers ten (10) years old on or before May 1st of the racing season and having two (2) years of experience in open wheels may enter this class. Maximum age is fifteen (15) years old. The sixteenth (16th) birthday must be after July 15th of the racing season year.

SuperStock – Driver must be at least thirteen (13) years old with two (2) years of racing experience. The thirteenth (13th) birthday must be on or before July 15th of the racing season year. Driver who are twelve (12) years old on or before May 1st of the racing season and have two (2) years of experience in open wheels may enter this class. Maximum age if not in high school, can race through the summer of the graduating year.
